He placed them in order of priority. (See Attached) It was discussed this would be the perfect year to do as many repairs as possible, since the Reservoir and Ditch is empty. We also need to take in account that this may not be a good year for Shareholders to have to pay the full call that was approved at the 2018 Annual meeting. (\$20.00) Since the water was in such short supply this year. There are repairs that must be completed to run water next year. It was decided to take the list and do the work over the next 2 or 3 years, doing the high priority items this year. The slide areas need work as soon as possible. There are culverts that are completely rusted out, etc... David would like Robert to look into placing the Flood Control Gates around the Hubbard's. He will get with the engineer who designs the gates. We will take the repair list to the 2019 Annual Stock Holders meeting to address the repairs then. Shellie will have the budget for October-April for the August meeting to help figure out what he can complete this year.
